Downloading the Zip File:

Access the content kit by downloading the provided zip file.

Contents of the Zip File:

Each content kit will include various files pertaining to the listed topic.

The kit may contain the following components:

- **Infographic/Informational Files:** One-pagers covering different aspects of the topic, suitable for co-branding and featuring a space for the user's rep office logo and contact information.
- **Presentation:** A presentation slide deck focused on the topic, designed for co-branding with space for the user's rep office logo.
- **Social Media Content:** Pre-packaged content optimized for use on social media platforms. Users can create high-quality posts using these assets. Additionally, links to AAON's previous social media posts related to the topic are provided for easy sharing.
- **Other Additional Content:** While not guaranteed, the kit may include supplementary assets such as:
 - Podcasts: Links to relevant podcast episodes.
 - Videos: Any video assets related to the content.
 - Further Resources: Links to additional knowledge base articles, technical papers, etc.
- **Instructions:** There will be brief instructions on how to use the content.

How to Customize a PDF

Customize:

1. Open the PDF file in Adobe Acrobat.

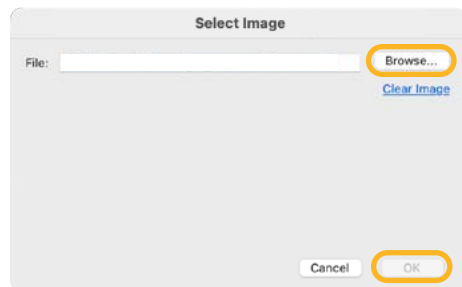


2. Find the **Contact Info and Logo** section at the bottom of your document:

3. Click on the **Photo Icon** and it will pull up the **Select Image** box.



Click **Browse**. Find your logo file on your computer and click **OK**.

4. Add your **Name and Contact Info** in the provided spaces.

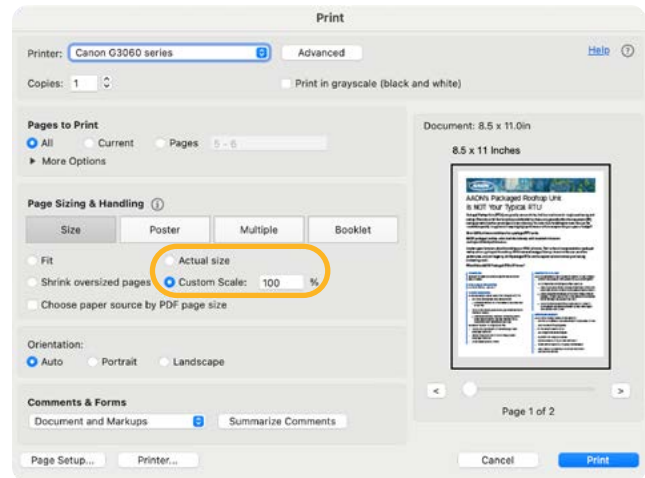

5. **Save** a copy of the PDF on your computer.
You can now **email** and **share** your customized PDF.

Printing a PDF:

If you wish to print the PDF, use the version with **_print** at the end of the file name. The **_print** files have a margin built in so should print on **letter size 8.5 x 11 inch** paper at **actual size** or **100%** with no trimming.
